Lighthouse Service Report

Between July 1 and Nov. 31:

374 Georgians received hearing aids through the Lighthouse. **127** of them are District A residents.

In November, **27** District A residents received hearing aids through the Lighthouse.

22 eye surgeries were performed in November bringing the total since July to **108**.

Between July 1 and October 31:

539 people received eye exams.

102 District A residents received an eye exam.

978 Georgians received a new pair of glasses.

225 of the glasses recipients are District A residents.
