From July to October 2009:

The Lions and the Lighthouse have restored hearing to **311** Georgians through the dispensation of **564 hearing aids**.

29 of the hearing aid patients were District D residents.

86 eye surgeries have been performed. **13** of the recipients were from District D.

539 Georgians have received a free **eye exam**, **38** of them from District D.

978 people have better vision after receiving a pair of **glasses**. **54** of the eyeglass recipients are from District D.

Demand for all services is up **30 percent** over last year.
